Camp Invention Summer STEM Program coming to Eastern Pulaski Elementary School

Camp Invention, a nationally recognized, nonprofit summer enrichment camp program, is coming to Eastern Pulaski Elementary School the week of June 15 - June 19.

A program of the National Inventors Hall of Fame (NIHF) in partnership with the United States Patent and Trademark Office, Camp Invention challenges children in grades K-6 to find their "inner inventor" by learning the process of innovation. Using hands-on activities, Camp Invention promotes science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) learning; builds confidence, leadership, perseverance, resourcefulness and problemsolving skills; and encourages entrepreneurship — in a fun and engaging environment.

Each year, the program features a new curriculum inspired by some of our nation's most world-changing

inventors — the NIHF Inductees. This year's Elevate curriculum features several video challenges from these inductees encouraging children to be confident in their ideas and explore their innovativeness. These hands-on activities include:

- Camp Invention Flight Lab: Imaginations soar as children learn about flight with gliders, rockets, heliballs and handcopters. They build a cityscape from upcycled materials, navigate planes through a storm and take apart a robot.
- Design Thinking Project: Campers learn the value of their creativity as they bring their biggest ideas to life. To become successful innovators, they create sketches, build prototypes, design logos and find out how to pitch their invention while protecting their intellectual property.
- Rescue Squad: Using teamwork and problem-solving

skills, children protect the Earth's ecosystems. Inspiring activities include creating pods to compete in zipline races, exploring energy conservation, eliminating pollution and helping wildlife in habitats across the country.

 Camp Invention Champions: As they discover the unseen inventors behind their favorite sports, campers apply their own ingenuity. They trade inventor playing cards, create and play their own high-energy hover-ball games, and design and build the ultimate sports complex.

At the end of the program, each camper will bring home a robot.


