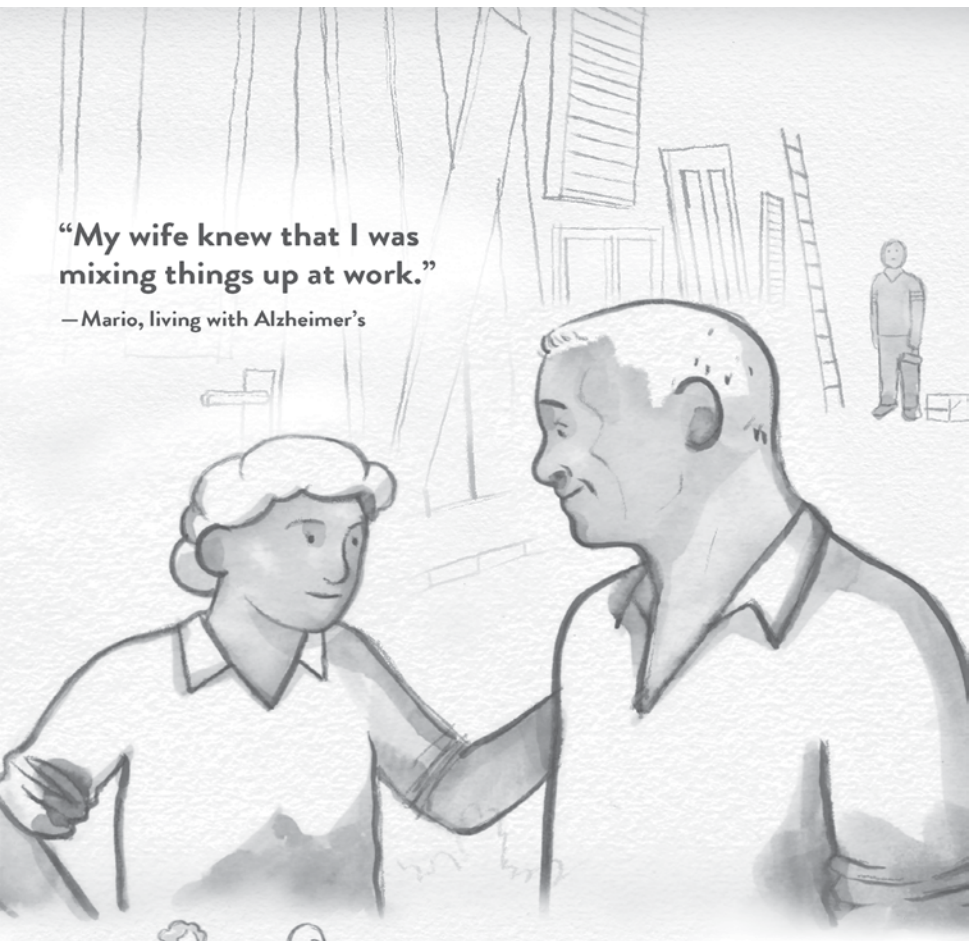

Two local residents want to see seed library grow

Often times in Pulaski County, residents start planning their gardens with the first brown leaf that falls from the tree. This comes from the deep history of living off the land; and although farming is more mechanized and less people are canning and gardening, many residents can name neighbors they know who still plant large gardens for the summer or can their own food. This winter, however, a different kind of planning was starting to take shape with two local residents.

Winamac resident Kyle Sefchek and Monterey resident Kaity Stacy started discussing the idea of starting a seed bank that could be accessed by all county residents, and because of that talk the Pulaski County Seed Library was born.

A seed library or seed bank is no new idea. There is a world seed bank in Greenland that stores seeds essential to the world's survival in case of a large event, and many local residents often save their own seed for the next harvest. However, Sefchek thought

the idea would work because, "Most of Pulaski County is in a food desert, and it's also a great way to bring the community together. We have lost touch with a lot of important information about gardening and how we fit in with our surrounding environment."

A food desert is a location labeled by the USDA, and an area qualifies when residents in an area have to drive more than 1 mile to access fresh produce. And while it is true that there are residents in the county that are quite removed from the nearest grocery store, most people live relatively close to a library; so, the pair thought that using the county libraries would be a good fit and give people easy access to the ability to grow their own food. Many of the local libraries in northern Indiana offer specialty services. Culver-Union Township library offers members the opportunity to check out fishing poles to fish in Lake Maxincuckee, and Pulaski County libraries offer free day passes to the Tippecanoe River State Park, so a seed library location seemed like a viable fit.

Also, many residents in the area that are serious gardeners are often forced to order seeds from long distances to find a plant that will suit their needs. For instance, several residents in Monterey like to can their own salsa and tomato sauce. They have gone to great lengths to find a tomato with fewer seeds. This plant from Poland does very well in the area. With the ability to save and share these seeds, residents that have had difficulty locating the breed can find themselves with an opportunity to make better salsa and sauce than someone can buy in the store while sharing their find with others who may be interested. But a local service like this also has benefits for the natural land.

While working out the kinks of how the project would go, Sefchek and Stacy decided that they shouldn't limit what kind of seeds the library holds because of Stacy's love of native plants. Stacy has spent most of her life collecting wild plants from around the area and transplanting them to places that have become forlorn. According to her, "Because I struggled as a gardener for quite a while, I thought I might get luckier with native plants. So, I just started by transplanting some daylilies that were growing wild and got hooked."

Finally, after several months of planning, the seed library came together this month, just in time for spring planting.

Monterey-Tippecanoe head librarian Renita Pothoff was excited to have the library start in Monterey. Pothoff stated, "Since we live in a rural area, this is the type of service people can use, and it launched just at the right time to make it something that people might drop by to check out."

The Pulaski County Seed Library is open in Monterey to all residents. Visitors can stop by to sign out seeds and will just need to present their ID. There is no cost, and residents are not required to return seeds in the fall.

However, in order for this to be a sustainable bank, Sefchek and Stacy are hoping that residents feel compelled to drop off seed donations as well.

Stacy said, "I know as a young gardener I often feel worried that I don't know what I am doing, so we have instructions to help people learn how to save seed."

Sefchek was key in developing easy instructions for any gardener to begin saving their own seed because of his horticulture background.

This seed library is a rare jewel that can become the pride of the county. The closest thing like it is near Brown County, and many in the area are already showing interest.

The group would like to encourage enough donations to fully stock three of the county libraries. Donations can be dropped off at the Pulaski County Public Library in Winamac, Francesville-Salem Township Library, or the Monterey-Tippecanoe Township branch. There is a quick slip for residents to fill out with all donations, and Sefchek and Stacy will ensure they are packaged and filed.

The plan is to see how things go through fall and then they are hoping to have full seed libraries at all Pulaski County library branches.
