The tradition of lights in Pulaski





More than 80 light displays brighten Pulaski for the holidays.

Holiday traditions come in many forms such as spending time with family, recognizing religious holidays and enjoying all kinds of delicious food.

For some families driving through Pulaski to view the lights has become a staple. Sometimes that tradition causes a bit of traffic congestion through the lanes that are at times only big enough for one vehicle. On weekends after 5 p.m. the traffic is a constant occurrence from Thanksgiving through the end of the year.

"It's kind of hard to get in and out of our driveway and you can only go one direction," said Brenda Gilsinger, who lives in Pulaski and has been a part of the Pulaski Light tradition since the first lighting.

The tradition of the lights began in 1990 after the Pulaski County Sesquicentennial in 1989. Gilsinger said

in honor of the sesquicentennial a tree was decorated and displayed and a few decorations were made for the street signs. A tree was then planted later. After that display started, the enthusiasm of the lights grew.

"We had the group from the sesquicentennial and we continued on as a community group," Gilsinger said. "It later became Pulaski Lights."

Gilsinger said in the past the whole town would decorate but now a few of the property owners don't. She said some of the other nearby homes also decorate.

"It's not like it used to be when the whole town decorated. Some of the lots we take care of ourselves. Some each landowner puts up," Gilsinger said. "We try to vary different things around."

The current light display features more than 80 light structures that were installed the weekend before Thanksgiving.

Gilsinger said having the lights on display that long "gives everyone the opportunity to come. We've even had a car from Alaska come through."

She said many times there are buses from the local health care centers that visit and sometimes even school buses or athletes as they are passing by.

The committee maintains several of the lights and when feasible purchases new ones. Each year various fundraisers or auctions are held to continue the tradition.

"This is all funded by donations," Gilsinger said.

The newest display is an electronic flagpole Christmas tree. Viewers can watch a two minute light show that includes sayings such as Merry Christmas.

Pulaski is located southwest of Winamac on SR 119. The lights are lit from 5-11 p.m.















