

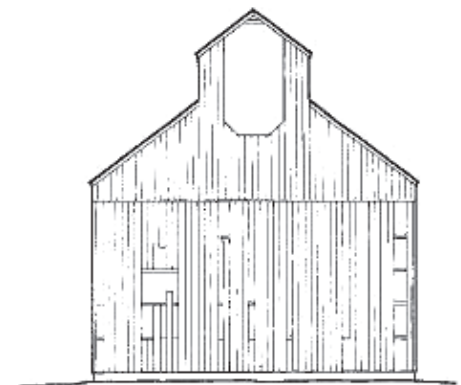
# Self-Guided Barn Tour

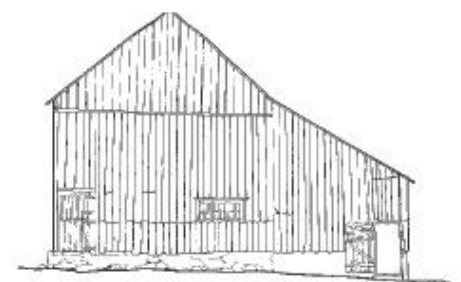

Roof Type: Gambrel



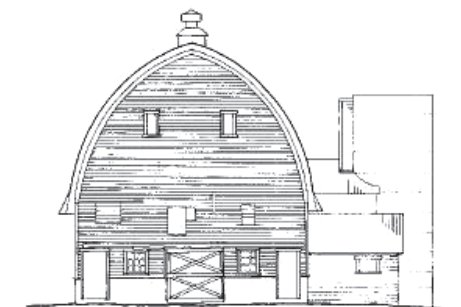

Roof Type: Monitor



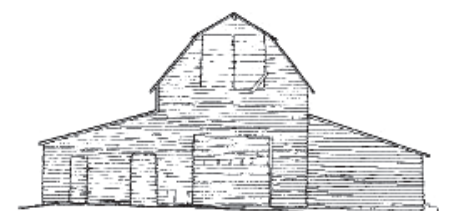

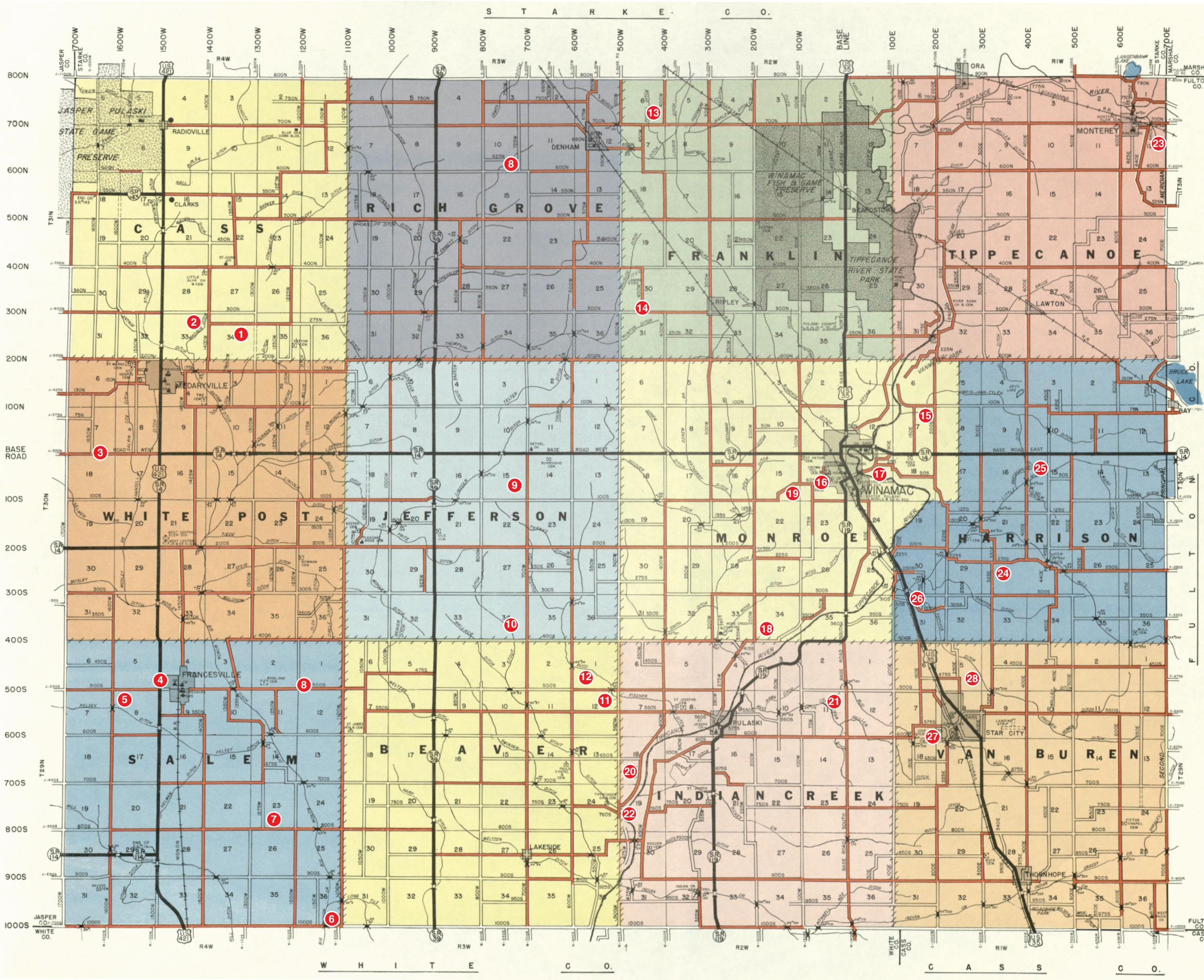
Roof Type: Arch
